<b>Summary of updates provided during the November meeting:</b>			
<p><b>GP Collective Action</b> The impact of collective action is being monitored with seven practices out of 32 indicating that they were participating in some form of collective action. Optometry services were also being monitored for any impact. Minimal impact had been observed at this time.</p> <p><b>Primary Care Quality Assurance Visit Report</b> Members were briefed on the NHS Greater Manchester (GM) (Stockport) approach on quality assurance visits to Stockport general practices. The visits provided opportunities for new developments to be shared across practices and support provided when requested. A key focus for practices remained on reducing health inequalities for Stockport residents.</p> <p>Key themes arising from the visits included: estate pressures, workforce pressures and variable models aligned to general practice access.</p> <p><b>Chadsfield Medical Practice Boundary Change Request</b> NHS GM (Stockport) had received a formal application to increase the geographical registration boundary of Chadsfield Medical Practice. An Equality Impact Assessment (EqIA) had been completed and no negative impact on patients had been identified. There would be a positive impact in that patient choice remained with an additional practice providing access to services. Following a discussion, the application was approved to include minor additions to existing boundaries. Neighbouring practices had not objected to the proposal.</p> <p><b>Finance Report for the period ending 31 October 2024 – Month 7</b> An update on the delegated primary care budget was received.</p>
