Purpose of the report:

To provide an update on Stockport Live Well, our approach to neighbourhoods and prevention, and outlines key areas of focus for 2025/26.

Key points (Executive Summary):

This update provides information on progress on the Stockport Live Well programme as a whole including further alignment with key strategies at the national and regional levels. It also provides specific update on the development of a neighbourhood network for each of the seven neighbourhoods.

The programme remains focused in its ambitions to deliver happy and healthy lives for everyone in Stockport through:

- **Stockport Live Well Centres, Bridges and Offers** – a range of places and offers that work together to support people to thrive by delivering easily accessible and high quality information, advice and support.
- **Stockport’s Neighbourhood Model** – a model to amplify the brilliant foundations for neighbourhood working that already exist across the borough by further coordinating and facilitating effective and efficient multi-disciplinary, multi-agency team working at the neighbourhood level.
- **Our relentless focus on prevention** – a workforce development programme that brings the whole Stockport Live Well workforce together towards collective learning to unlock our collective passion to help Stockport thrive.
- **VCFSE Collaboration** – investment and capacity building for the VCFSE sector to support our brilliant VCFSE sector, grow community-led solutions, and shift resources and investment to reactive statutory services to preventative community work.
- **Health & Care Integration** – delivering integrated and person-centred services built on a model of care in which collaborative teams focus on prevention, early intervention and proactive care, supporting people to be healthier, happier and independent in our neighbourhoods.
