## Purpose of the report:

To provide an update on Stockport Live Well, our approach to neighbourhoods and prevention, and outlines key areas of focus for 2025/26.

## **Key points (Executive Summary):**

This update provides information on progress on the Stockport Live Well programme as a whole including further alignment with key strategies at the national and regional levels. It also provides specific update on the development of a neighbourhood network for each of the seven neighbourhoods.

- VCFSE Collaboration investment and capacity building for the VCFSE sector to support our brilliant VCFSE sector, grow community-led solutions, and shift resources and investment to reactive statutory services to preventative community work
- Health & Care Integration delivering integrated and person-centred services built on a model of care in which collaborative teams focus on prevention, early intervention and proactive care, supporting people to be healthier, happier and independent in our neighbourhoods.
