<b>Summary of updates provided during the January meeting:</b>			
<p><b>Update from Stockport Primary Care Board</b>  Items of discussion at the meeting included: Shared Care arrangements (transfer of care from a specialist to a GP such as the prescribing of specialist medicines) / update on the Community Diagnostic Centre (CDC) for Stockport and Tameside and a presentation on the proposed Frailty Model.</p> <p><b>GP Collective Action</b>  Based on data provided there has been minimal impact observed. The impact of collective action will continue to be monitored.</p> <p><b>Primary Care Quality Report</b>  Members were informed that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The locality is on track to meet performance targets for Serious Mental Illness (SMI) health checks and Learning Disability health checks.</li> <li>• Friends and Family Test remained at 95%.</li> <li>• Stockport had the highest uptake in Greater Manchester (GM) across all cohorts for Covid vaccinations and planning had commenced for the spring vaccination programme.</li> <li>• Stockport was currently the highest performing locality across GM for Cervical Screening and Bowel Screening and second highest for Breast Screening.</li> </ul> <p>It was noted that a BeCCoR (Beyond Care Contract) review had commenced with a Task and Finish Group established to consider changes and improvements to contract to deliver better outcomes for patients.</p> <p><b>Assurance on Primary Care Blueprint</b>  Members updated on the work that was taking place to meet the ambitions of the Primary Care Blueprint.</p> <p><b>Finance Report for the period ending 31 December 2024 – Month 9</b>  An update on the delegated primary care budget was received.</p>
