Compstall Cricket Club is dedicated to fostering and promoting participation in amateur cricket within the community by providing accessible facilities for playing, coaching, and competition. Beyond cricket, the Club serves as a vital hub for the local community, offering a welcoming green space for residents to enjoy. We host a range of affordable events and activities designed to bring people together, with a particular focus on engaging young people. The funds raised from these events help maintain our facilities and support our long-term vision of expanding the Club's role as a community space. Our aim is to build momentum and secure funding to develop the clubhouse further, allowing us to offer room hire and host activities such as baby groups, yoga classes, and other community-led initiatives in the future.

9. Please give us a brief description of your proposed/planned project or activity You may wish to include details of what activities will take place, where will it happen, how often and who will take part. Our project aims to enhance community engagement and wellbeing by hosting a series of inclusive events and activities at Compstall Cricket Club. These include our upcoming Easter event, a children's summer party, a Halloween event, and **Compstall Stars**, our cricket tuition program for children aged 5-11. These activities provide local people, especially young children, with opportunities not only to participate in sport and recreation but also to connect with others, improve their wellbeing and learn new skills.

To support the delivery of these events, we are seeking funding for foldable tables and stackable chairs. These will allow us to maximise the use of our space, adapting it to suit different activities while ensuring it remains accessible for all. The flexibility of this equipment will enable us to set up and clear spaces efficiently, making it easier for our volunteers to organise events. By creating a more versatile space, we can continue to offer a range of activities that bring people together, support personal development, and strengthen our community.

10. Who will benefit from this grant?

e.g. local residents, young people, older people and how?

This grant will benefit a wide range of **local people**, including **young children** who participate in **Compstall Stars**, our cricket tuition program for ages 5-11, giving them the chance to develop their skills, stay active, and build confidence. It will also support **local residents** who volunteer at the club, including **older people**, by making event setup and organisation easier and more accessible. Additionally, the funding will help us create a more flexible and welcoming space for **local groups** who are looking for a community venue to connect, engage in activities, and support one another.

10(a) How Many Stockport residents will benefit?

Approximately **1,650 Stockport residents** will benefit from this grant each year. This includes an average of **500 people attending each of our three major events** (Easter, Summer, and Halloween), **60 children participating in Compstall Stars**, **40 cricketers who regularly use the club**, and around **50 people who will benefit from future community space hire opportunities**. This funding will help us enhance our facilities, ensuring that these activities continue to support local people by providing opportunities for sport, recreation, wellbeing, and community connection.

We will be raising funds at our Easter event to purchase the additional tables and chairs we need for the room.

11(b) Tell us about other any other sources of income you have already applied for or raised so far in relation to this project

Since beginning our fundraising activities, we have successfully raised £4,000, which has been used to improve our facilities, including installing a baby changing unit, carrying out essential maintenance of the pavilion (such as painting the space and benches), and ensuring the care of the pitch. While these improvements have enhanced the club for the community, we are now focusing on raising funds specifically for foldable tables and stackable chairs to make our space more versatile. Our upcoming Easter event will contribute towards this goal, helping us generate additional funds to support the purchase of this essential equipment.

This funding will provide us with a strong starting point, allowing us to purchase some of the foldable tables and stackable chairs needed to make our space more versatile. To cover the remaining costs, we will use funds raised from our **Easter event** and **summer event**, which will help us purchase the rest of the tables and chairs needed to fully equip the space. By continuing our fundraising efforts, we aim to ensure that the club can accommodate a wide range of community activities and events.
